The *Enunciación* journal, a biannual scientific publication of Universidad Distrital Francisco José de Caldas, led by the Language, Culture, and Identity Research Group, issues a call for researchers, teachers, and professionals interested in participating in our Thematic Issue 31(1) of 2026. This edition will be dedicated to exploring the thematic and research relationships between language, audiovisual media, and technology.

Objective of the thematic issue

To consolidate a space for academic and research reflection on audiovisual media, digital technologies, and artificial intelligence in the transformation of communication, education, teaching-learning, and meaning construction practices in diverse sociocultural contexts.

Thematic axes of this call

We are open to receiving contributions that address, among others, the following topics:

1. Language, communication, and digital culture

- New narratives, multimediality, and transmedia in education and communication
- Asocial and cultural appropriations of digital media
- Participative cultures, prosumers, and collective creation dynamics

2. Audiovisual media in educational processes and expanded education

- Pedagogical practices mediated by audiovisual and digital resources
- Creation and production of audiovisual materials for managing teaching-learning processes
- Community media in educational contexts



3. Emerging technologies and language

- AI-mediated transmedia production
- New forms of expression, remix, and co-authorship in algorithmic environments
- Impact of prompting in text comprehension and production
- Artificial intelligence, videogames, augmented reality, and their ethical, aesthetic, and political implications in social, communicative, and educational practices
- Digital and media literacy

4. Educational experiences, research, and interdisciplinary projects in diverse environments

- Accounts of innovative educational or research experiences integrating technology, audiovisual media, and teaching-learning experiences
- Communication practices and interdisciplinary collaborative projects
- Reading, writing, and production practices in virtual environments
- Social media, digital platforms, and educational communication
- Digital writing, hypertextuality, and new forms of expression
